Sponsored We Care Coalition's Weekend of Hope to raise awareness of youth mental health. The speaker presented to local youth groups, Breckenridge High School, a parents/adults event and provided an eight hour professional training.

370 patients from the St. Francis and Milnor Clinic screened positive for social needs (e.g. food, housing, transportation, etc.) and were contacted by a community health worker to offer resources.

Health Related Social Needs

The Farm at St. Francis project received an additional three years of funding. The Farm produced 2,297 tons of food, which was donated to the Wahpeton food pantry.
